

**Important Note:** These Richards cannot be the Richard Woodward born 15 June 1700 in Morton Bagot to Robert and Ann, as he died on 13 Oct 1701 at Morton Bagot. The death is not in the parish record but is in the Bishop's Transcript, which shows the burial of "Richard, son of Robert and Ann".

Who was this Richard? Is it the same Richard who married twice? Having two William and two Sarah children alive at the same time is unusual for this to be the case, although not impossible.

The events on this tree have all been verified against the parish records and secondary evidence (witnesses at weddings etc) as far as is practically possible, but are not guaranteed.
